

MERTEN AND GERALDINE WHYMAN HEALTH CAREERS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Please read the guidelines carefully.

For a completed application, applicants must fill out the application form, community involvement grid and have two references forms postmarked no later than April 1st.

APPLICATIONS:

Applicants must submit a scholarship application & the community involvement grid postmarked no later than April 1 for consideration. Applications must be mailed and will not be accepted if hand delivered. Applicants must:

- 1) Pursue a health-related career;
- 2) Be a Clinton County resident;
- 3) Be in good academic standing;

REFERENCES:

Two references are required. One of the two references needs to be from an instructor or educator who has worked with the student and the second reference should be from an employer or volunteer community organization. Reference sheets must be completed and postmarked no later than April 1. References must be mailed and will not be accepted if hand delivered. To be considered for the Whyman Health Careers Scholarship two references are required. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that his/her references have been received in the Clinton Memorial Hospital Foundation office.

AVAILABILITY:

Applications will be available at all Clinton County public and parochial schools and the Clinton Memorial Hospital Foundation. You can download an electronic application at www.clintonmemorial.org under Whyman Scholarship

Scholarships are available to any Clinton County resident pursuing an education in a health-related field and are awarded on an annual basis.

The number of scholarships and the amount of scholarship monies awarded may vary yearly as determined by the Whyman Scholarship Committee.

The Selection Committee will review each application and reach its decision prior to May 1 of each year.

The Whyman Scholarship Selection Committee includes select members of the Clinton Memorial Hospital Foundation Committee and one of the Clinton County School Superintendents.

The Whyman Scholarship Committee will determine awards based on the returned applications and reference forms.
