EVE's Outreach advocates can help make necessary connections with area agencies to help clients utilize available resources.

Our goal is to help victims evaluate their strengths and build upon them to further **EMPOWER** themselves. Advocates work closely with clients to examine and prioritize their needs. Then they assist in creating a set of smaller goals that will ultimately allow the woman to reach her final goal. EVE's Outreach also assists clients in locating and obtaining a wide variety of resources from within the community and is able to **provide referrals** as needed.



We should NOT be asking,
“Why don't battered women just leave?”

The real question is,
“Why doesn't he stop hitting her?”

**Break the cycle of abuse.
Ask for help. We are here for you.**

Housing: Provide resources to find a safe and affordable home.

PPO: Assistance with Personal Protection Orders to help move towards safety from the assailant.

Legal Help: Referrals to appropriate agencies.

Safety Planning: Developing and implanting a plan to stay safe when faced with violence and also how to avoid violence.

Back Rent/ Preventing Eviction: Help obtaining funding to prevent client from losing her home.

Relocation: Fleeing the assailant– finding other safe shelter.

Crime Victim Compensation: Compensation for injuries and other losses incurred because of assault.

Employment: Provide outside resources to assist client in finding a job that suits the individual's skills and needs.

Transportation– Provided only for clients. Is limited to EVE participants, to assist in rides to appointments.

Court Support: Accompany clients to court hearings for emotional support.

Goal Setting: Help client organize and prioritize her needs.

EVE's Outreach Non-Residential Services

- **Advocacy:** Advocates can meet with client in public places, over the phone or at the shelter.
- Complete **confidentiality** for the privacy and safety of clients.
- **Transportation** can be arranged. It is limited to clients who are working within the program.
- **Free local calling** while attending programs at the shelter.
- **Access to clothing** EVE works with St. Lawrence Resale Shop and those who demonstrate need and are currently participating in EVE's programs can qualify for vouchers.
- **Referrals** to other agencies and/or shelters.
- **Bilingual services** available.
